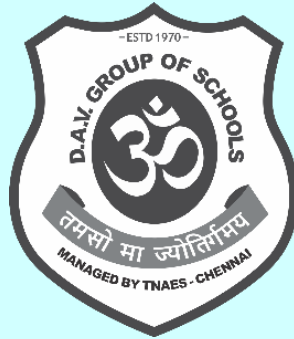

- ❖ The students of D.A.V. BOYS GOPALAPURAM have designed and developed an innovative, and informative website (<https://bgpm.davchennai.org>)
- ❖ .A unique set of **Co-Scholastic Activities-** Toastmasters, ICT, Mental Ability, Junior Scientist etc was introduced this year to make learning a joy for students and equip them with certain important skills for their future.
- ❖ **Online Career Guidance Webinar** which is open to both DAV and non-DAV students is organized on the first and third Saturdays of the month to provide high-quality career guidance.
- ❖ To instill a sense of patriotism and respect for our Defence forces, **printed wall calendars** issued by the Defence forces were distributed to students who had requested for the same.

- ❖ **DAV Prajya Exam-** To equip the NTSE aspirants with the right kind of preparation to crack the prestigious exam, multiple exams have been designed for classes 6th to 10th every academic year. The aim is to enable the students to have a good idea of the level of the exam and evaluate their mastery of all the topics required, and also motivate students to endeavour for a deeper understanding of the curriculum and enhance their reasoning, analytical, and problem-solving skills.
- ❖ Top Performers of various **Olympiad Examinations** were identified and honoured for their talents.
- ❖ As part of the **Gyaan Pravah** (Flow of Knowledge) initiative, children from economically disadvantaged backgrounds are provided with a unique opportunity to study English and

Maths (Primary level) as an after-school programme from 4 to 6 p.m at the Boys Gopalapuram School campus.

- ❖ **Agnihotra** is performed in the school campus by teachers regularly. Students participate virtually and the aura relaxes the mind, heals the body, and has positive effects spiritually. Birthday Mantra in Sanskrit is chanted at the end of the havan to bless the students celebrating their birthdays.

Co-scholastic Report

Education without co-curricular activities is like educating the mind without educating the soul. DAV adapted seamlessly to the changing times, as part of which, the school brought about various co-curricular activities to keep students of classes I-XII engaged and enhance their skills at the same time. Conducted weekly, these activities aimed at developing various skills of the students.

The ICT(Information Communication Technology) sessions taught the students to handle different digital necessities which the changing times demanded from the students. Teachers were involved in teaching students various applications from the basic office applications to video editing and coding. Seasoned Yoga teachers from the DAV faculty, taught students different yoga postures and exercising methods along with Pranayama in an activity called 'live strong'. Students learned to make delicious and mouth-watering dishes like sandwiches, salads, *kashyams*(herbal concoctions), and different types of drinks in a session called 'Culinary Arts'. Teachers demonstrated the procedure of making dishes during classes and students went on to do the same using the recipe cards which were handed to them.

Mock Parliament and The Model United Nations classes took place, in which several debate sessions were held. Model bill sessions were conducted in which students proposed their views on reforms to be brought into the school. Teachers and students spent classes in an interactive manner where they discussed in detail some current affairs. Teachers taught the students various lessons in personality development, school activities, and creative writing in an activity called Toastmaster.

Students took part in other activities including mental ability, first aid, and gardening. Apart from co-scholastic classes, students also participated in online inter-class competitions which motivated students to perform their best. 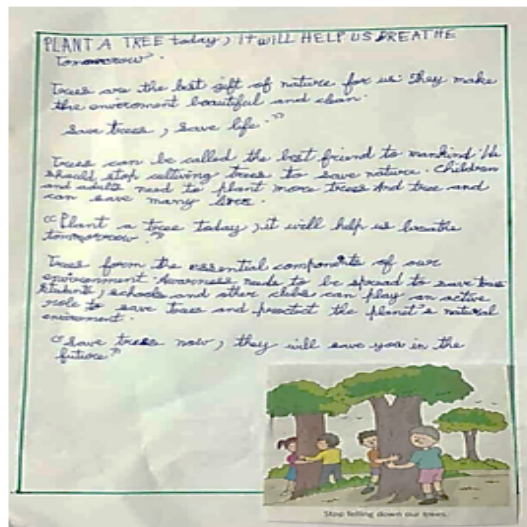
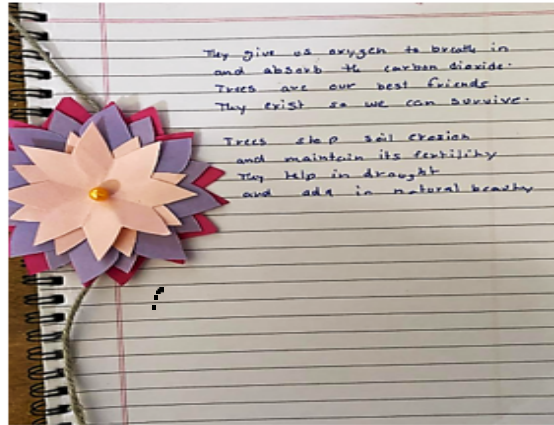
ECO CLUB EXHIBITION – ACITIVITY ON 3R'S

In February, class 8 students made slides on the topic - Afforestation. Based on this activity, students did a comparative study on Afforestation, Deforestation & Reforestation.

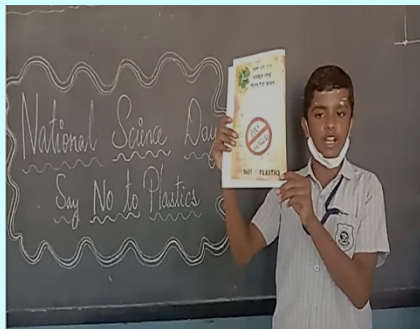

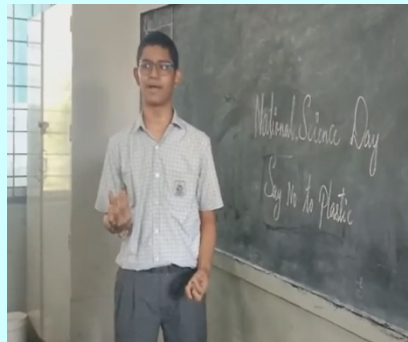

ACTIVITIES OF ARYA SAMAJ DURING 2021-22

The regular activities of Arya Samaj during 2021-22 were curtailed for the second year running. Due to restrictions in gatherings in places of worship because of a resurgence in the covid pandemic, the Sunday satsangs could not be held. However, Arya Samaj continued to utilise the virtual platform to conduct satsangs every Sunday as usual, and these virtual satsangs are continuing till date. In fact, there is wide participation in the online satsangs from all over India, and even from abroad, and high quality discourses are rendered by the renowned Arya Samaj pracharak, Acharya Raju Vaigyanik. The physical Sunday satsangs commenced only in November, 2021 but had to be stopped in early January, 2022. They were resumed in February, with participation by the students of the DAV Group of schools. Of course, all protocols and guidelines with reference to the pandemic were observed.

The curtailment of the satsangs in the Arya Samaj organisations throughout the country resulted in loss of livelihood of numerous Vedic scholars and pracharaks. Arya Samaj, Chennai responded to the situation, and launched a program of financial

assistance to about 500 such scholars spread throughout the country. Other organisations, like the Sarvadeshik Arya Pratinidhi Sabha and Haryana Pradeshik Sabha, as well as a few individuals also pitched in and helped them tide through the difficult period.

In addition, a Gurukul has been set up at the Arya Samaj premises in Triplicane, and has started functioning from December 15, 2021. There are 23 students from different places in India, under the stewardship of 3 Acharyas. This is a major milestone in the annals of Arya Samaj in Chennai, and we hope it will result in the advancement of Vedic knowledge of a high order.

Another significant initiative has been the commencement of online booking of requests for participation in the satsangs as yajmans, as well as for assigning purohits for performing ceremonies like marriage, house warming, upanayam sanskar as well as anteyshti and shanti homams.

Marriages: 52 nos.

Shuddhi: 54 nos.

Homam: 215 nos.
